

Completion Requirements:

1. Completion of online modules.
2. Completion of all required Certification workshop days.
3. Documentation of completion of Certification Consultation hours.
4. Letter from the Certification Consultant(s) attesting to the quality of the applicant's utilization of CEP while in the consulting relationship.
5. Documentation of having provided a minimum of 50 energy psychology sessions to at least 25 different clients. (A notarized document attesting to this fact is sufficient.)

Certification Renewal

Renewal period: every two years.

Renewal fee:

\$95 for ACEP members

\$295 for non-members

Standard ACEP membership is \$95/yr.

To retain certification, the DCEP or CEHP must provide documentation every two years of completion of at least 12 hours of ACEP credits (continuing education in CEP), including at least two hours of ethics addressing the special ethical and legal issues that arise with Energy Psychology. See the ACEP website for details on ways to fulfill this requirement.

Eligibility Criteria for CEHP Certification Track:

One or more of the following:

1. Hold a license or registration in an allied helping profession (e.g., acupuncturist, chiropractor, physician, nurse, or dentist)
2. Hold an advanced degree, certification or authorization in a helping field (e.g., healing touch, mediator, focusing trainer, educator or child care professional, holistic health practitioner, coach, career counselor, authorized hospice worker, massage therapist, reflexologist, clergy, Heilpraktikum, etc.)
3. Hold a mental health-related job title working for either a governmental or non-governmental agency (e.g., crisis counselor, child custody worker, probation officer, etc.)
4. Verify having practiced a minimum of two years while marketing oneself to the public as a helping professional, using a title in which no licensure, registration or certification requirements exist in one's location, in that specialty area.

DCEP

Diplomate, Comprehensive Energy Psychology, is for licensed mental health professionals (or the equivalent in your location to being licensed) .

CEHP

Certified Energy Health Practitioner is for a broad range of allied health and human potential fields and/or those whose academic degrees are in mental health but who are not licensed mental health practitioners.

Application Requirements:

1. Certification Application Form. A download of the application is available from the ACEP website. After submitting the application, home study module exam links and instructions will be sent. Processing fee: \$150 for ACEP members, \$250 for non-members
(Standard ACEP membership is \$95/yr.)

2a. For DCEP: Evidence of a valid license, certification or registration as a mental health professional independently providing services. A photocopy of the applicant's license/certification/registration (or equivalent for those who practice in a location that does not require licensure, certification or registry) is required.

2b. For CEHP: Evidence of qualifications and an explanation of which of the four CEHP Eligibility Criteria the applicant meets.

3. Documentation of at least two years of experience in the mental health field or allied health field. A notarized document attesting to this fact is sufficient.

4. Two letters of recommendation regarding the ethics in practice and professional character of the applicant. This is to address the applicant's general professional character and may be written by professional colleagues.

Program Components:

1. Conceptual Clarity: Home-study modules are available on-line, provided through and using portions of ***Energy Psychology Interactive***. DCEP requires 11 modules, and CEHP requires 13 modules.

2. Technical and Ethical Competence: completion of a three-day Certification Workshop for all candidates and a fourth workshop day for CEHP candidates covering counseling skills, dealing with trauma, how to spot complex psychological issues, and knowing when to refer.

3. Treatment Proficiency: A minimum of 20 hours of Certification Consultation with an ACEP-approved Certification Consultant. Up to ten of these hours may be small group consultation.
